


Review of Project Bids


Indian Trail Culvert Location

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Re: River Road Repair Needs and Options

River Road is not included in the 2017 Street Improvements Project, so has the need for significant temporary repairs. Ben Thurmes, of TriCounty, has proposed skim coat patching, similar to what was done on Afton Hills Drive and 15th Street, at an estimated cost of \$25,000. The Council approved that work and cost, but the approval was subject to the Public Works Committee's review. Council member Richter has suggested the Committee may want to consider a cut and patch solution. The Committee will tour River Road with Ben Thurmes to view the extent of repair needs and discuss options for addressing those needs.
