Business:

- A. **Town Square Park.** The hockey rink has been installed, and programable lights purchased. The fire department will come and fill the rink and the warming house will be set up. Hours need to be set and then the lights and heater will be programmed to turn off automatically. One restroom will be left open, and tables will be moved nearby. Bales of straw will be obtained as well, so that there will be sitting space for parents to observe. A mini zamboni will be obtained as well as a walker type device for teaching youth how to skate. Yellow bumpers are on their way, which will be placed over the boards for protection. Also, fencing options for the park will continue to be explored, both for the ball field and the courts in the park. These fences possibly could be removable.
- B. **Bike Trails.** Bjorn from the bike shop is moving, but the committee thought they and other bicyclers in the community can complete the map, showing optimal routes for families, skate skiers, and out of towners wanting a hilly workout. The possibility of extending the bike trail along the length of the dike was discussed.
- C. **Levee Plantings.** The Army Corp of Engineers has approved a plan for planting different vegetation on the dike. Funding may be available from conservation groups. The parks committee will turn their attention to this project as spring approaches, since the plantings and mulching for the pollinator trail behind city hall is complete.
