First Order of Business:

Second Order of Business:

Third Order of Business: Agenda Discussion.

1. Meadow Ridge. Chairman Jensen announced that the grant submitted by the Parks Commission with the collaboration of the City of Afton has been submitted with final approval anticipated in Mid-December.
2. Pollinator project. A donated bench has been added to north side of the bike/walking trail, bags will be put around trees to protect from critters, the Parks Commission was favorably inclined to add additional trees to the trail.
3. Bicycle Routes. Bjorn at Velo has begun the process of locating bicycle routes and will continue to work with Committee member Dickie to present a map proposal to the Parks Commission. Bjorn will be given a digital copy of the County map for Afton. Once final bike, walk and skate routes have been approved, the Parks Commission will make recommendations for signage.
