Business:

- A. **Future Meetings: Zoom or in Person.** Future meetings will take place at City Hall with a zoom link also available for those unable to attend the meeting in person. Ron Morse will speak to a videographer concerning the camera and audio set-up before the April meeting.
- B. **Meadow Ridge Project.** Tree removal has begun. Neighbors have been sent postcards to will be keep them informed about the project as it goes forward.
- C. **City Hall Project.** Two oaks on either side of the bench have been damaged by deer. Trees and shrubs will therefore be wired or fenced.
- D. **Bike Routes.** Bike route maps should be ready this summer. A larger scale version of the map is also being prepared. Signage will follow later.
- E. **Recycling Bins.** The Minnesota Waste Wise Foundation can provide recycling bins for Town Square Park. Washington County will cover the cost of their installation. Members saw photos of various bin types available, voicing their preference for the simpler bin style because the instructions are clear and thus would be the easiest for all to use. The Afton City Council will continue to work with business owners to further the use of recyclable and/or biodegradable materials.
- F. **Long-term Planning.** The committee continued its discussion of future projects and priorities. New members will be sent a Parks Committee binder containing a previous long-term planning survey and other pertinent materials before the April meeting.
