### 5. BUSINESS

- I. Design Review Krista and Steven Dorgan Health/Wellness Center at 3185 St. Croix Trail South: Thomas; Livingston; pass
  - After much discussion on historic details (trims, paint color, windows, size of roof deck, etc.) everyone agreed on these items:
    - o Remove door side windows
    - o Add at least one window to the attic gable
    - o Add trim wrap to the top of columns
    - o Add rails to the end of porches
    - o Make all siding horizontal (including gables; if funds allow use shakes on west/street gable).
  - Strongly suggested if funds allow: add skinny sills to windows and wrap bottom of columns
  - Designer also clarified that the drawing shows shingles on the porch roof but the rest of the building will have a metal roof
  - No decision from owner on paint color yet other than probably a historic blue; no decision on width of LP siding
  - Parking discussed with Afton Historical Society President Stan Ross, but agreement needs to be with the City of Afton since they own the building and land (rented to the museum).
- II. MN Department of Transportation Invitation to Serve as Consulting Party on the 95/CSAH 18 Roundabout
  - Yes, the HPC would like to consult with MN DOT
- III. AHS update (Leslie): none but we all received the email that city gov't people are invited to the AHS Interpretive Plan Focus Group on Monday 6/17/2024. There will be other focus groups if one can't attend this meeting.
- IV. Plaque project (KT)
  - a. Owners contacted? (Kathy/Jill)
    - Everyone on Jill's list said yes to a bronze plaque: Cushing (Afton Inn), Village School (next to HortaCulture), Selma's, Citizen's State Bank, Carnithan-Squires House. Jill will check about putting the plaque on the Afton House Inn since they have their own hand-make one; also that the plaque will read "Cushing Hotel" as the historic name.
    - Kathy not here; Kate will check in with her
    - Bill will check with the City Council and Park committee -- maybe a stone near the entrance? He'll also ask AHS about a plaque on the building ("Congregation

Church").

- b. Decide final design (show Jacob's example):
  - Shown and everyone agrees on the design and wording.
  - Hold off on ordering until we get matching hours and know placement of the plaques (on buildings or by sidewalk)
- c. Remember to log your hours
- V. Walking Tour QR Code Project
  - a. Next steps for what will appear online (KT): wait until the next meeting
    See Leslie's email with her suggested changes; decide final text

  - b. QR code signs and window clings (KT)
    - Updated designs from Stillwater: 10x10 metal, 5x5 window clings (double-sided); cost: Metal 10x10 \$80+set-up; clings 5x5 \$5+set-up
    - Kate showed PowerPoint examples: all agreed to this wording with the same font as the Stillwater example and the same blue color
      - o Top line: Afton History Spots
      - o Tiny second line: A Project of Afton Heritage Commission and Afton Historical Society
      - o Big middle line: Old Village Walking Tour
      - o Bottom line with QR code: Scan me to learn more
    - Need single map file from Leslie; still needed
    - Kate will call for cost estimates for signs and window clings
  - d. Locations for signs: Kate walked around and took photos. Will present next month.
    - > Ron will check with county if we can attach signs to their road posts
    - ➤ Kate will ask Matt how they are attaching their signs elsewhere.
    - ➤ Park Bulletin Board & City Hall Display Case these can be window clings
    - ➤ Levee walk location?
