Re: Heidi Kassenborg and Grant Gugisberg Complaint and Request Regarding Declaration of Dangerous Dog.

Council members Randy Nelson and Stan Ross requested that a Special Council meeting be held at 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, July 30 to reconsider the Council's action regarding the Dangerous Dog declaration made by the Council at its July 21 regular meeting. The purpose of the reconsideration is to stay any action regarding the dangerous dog declaration until the August 18 Council meeting, when both the residents who have requested the dangerous dog declaration and the owners of the dog can attend the meeting to ensure due process; and so that the Council can have an opportunity to better understand both the specific situation regarding the dog and the dangerous dog statute.

Council Action Requested:

Motion regarding the reconsideration of the Council's action to declare the dog that killed the pet goose of Heidi Kassenborg and Grant Gugisberg a dangerous dog, and to stay any further action regarding the dangerous dog declaration until the August 18 Council meeting.
