City Council Pay

Council member Ross has requested that the Council discuss increasing the level of pay for the Mayor and Council. The pay for the City Council was last increased in 2006, effective 2007, when the Mayor's monthly pay was increased from \$150 to \$300 and the Council members' pay was increased from \$100 to \$200. Attached is a summary of the results of a survey of other cities regarding Mayor and Council member pay. In order to implement an increase in Council pay, an increase must be approved prior to an election and does not become effective until after the election.
