




The Wirecast software that runs the Council Chambers A/V system is an older version. While the Wirecast software is able to provide for live streaming of the Council and Planning Commission meetings, there are a number of technical issues that could be resolved by upgrading the Wirecast software. The upgrade requires a subscription with an annual cost of \$600. This cost can be funded from the Computer Services line-item of the annual budget.
